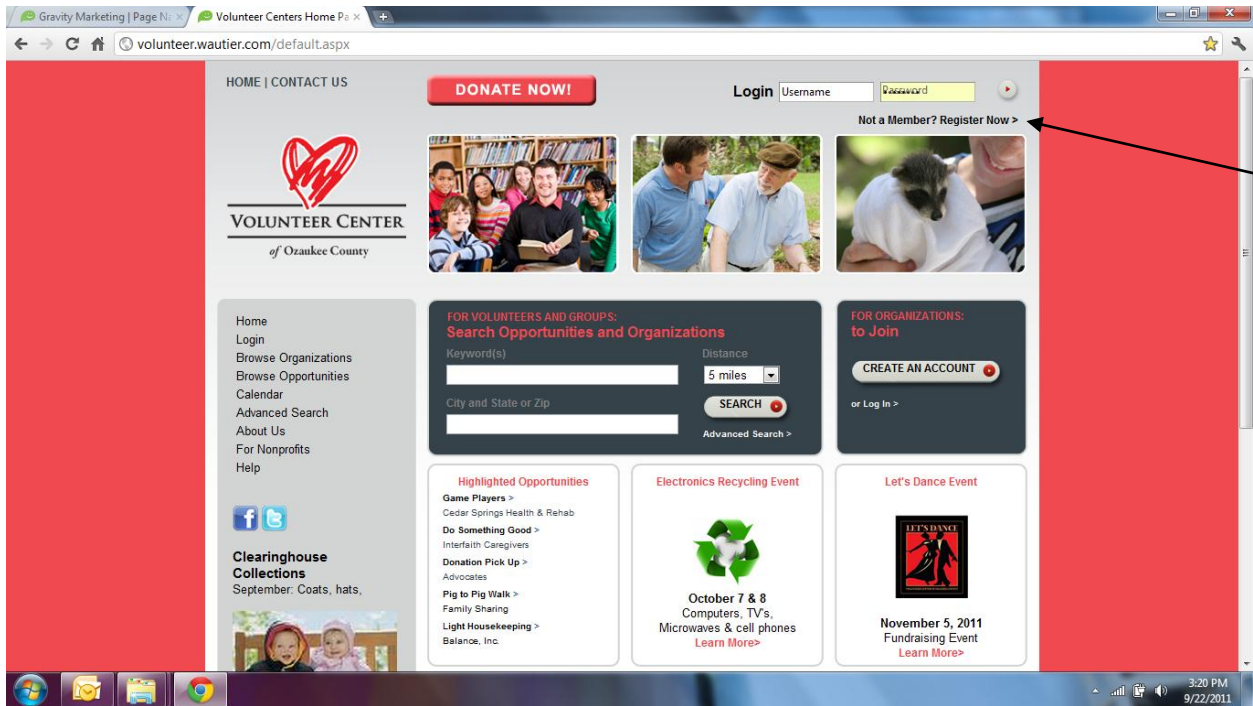


The Volunteer Center of Ozaukee County Volunteer User Manual

How to Create a User Account

Even if you created a user account on our old site you will need to create a new account in order to indicate your interest for new volunteer opportunities. It should only take a few moments, and then you will be on your way. You may create a new user account directly from the home page, top right hand corner, below the login information, select register now.




You will then be redirected to the 'Create an Account' window. Press 'Volunteer Sign-up' to create an account for a single user or groups of multiple volunteers.

Searching for Volunteer Opportunities

Regardless of whether you are logged in or not, you may search for volunteer opportunities. To do so, select either 'Browse Organizations' or 'Browse Opportunities' from the gray menu bar on the left.

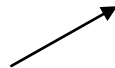
